Wednesday 15th May Arrival at Bordeaux

We will meet at Dublin airport in the morning before flying to Bordeaux, arriving in the afternoon. From there we transfer directly to the 4* Hôtel Mercure Centre-Ville. You will have time to settle in and explore the beautiful

city of Bordeaux before dinner at Brasserie Bordelaise. Here we will taste some wonderful local cuisine along with our first taste of the Bordeaux wine.

Thursday 16th May Mouton & Beyond

We are starting our trip in an incredible way with a visit to Château Mouton-Rothchild, one of the best estates in the world. Mouton is a story of firsts the first to bottle their wine at the estate, the first to feature works from famous artists on the label and the only estate to move up to the exclusive 'first growth' status in Bordeaux's classification. We will then visit the Medoc estate of **Château**

Sigognac, including lunch overlooking the winery, before a visit to the excellent Cos d'Estournel. This beautiful winery sits on the edge of Pauillac, in St-Estephe, producing incredibly powerful & complex wines. Later, for dinner, we will travel to Pessac Leognan, to Chateau Latour-Martillac, for an unforgettable evening meal.

Friday 17th May The Right Bank

On Friday we will visit the historic town of St Emilion. Our first winery will be the incredible Château Clos Fourtet. This I er Grand Cru Classé estate sits just outside the town and has established itself as one of the finest. Lunch will be at L'Envers du Décor after which there will be a

chance to explore the picturesque scenery, before a visit to one of the most exclusive St. Emilion estates. Château Troplong Mondot. In the evening we will travel outside Pomerol, to Château La Fleur de Boüard, for a tour & evening meal.





Saturday 18th May Margaux & Arcachon

Saturday begins in Margaux, at the wonderful Château Kirwan. One of Bordeaux's 'Wild Geese' estates. Kirwan was founded by an Irish businessman in the 18th century. After a tour of the winery and a tasting of the estate's wines, we will be treated to a lunch overlooking the famous vineyards of Margaux.

From there, we will travel up the coast to the town of Arcachon. From it's world famous food hall, to the

exquisite oyster bars & the picturesque beach, this is the perfect place to relax & unwind. Then, for the evening, we will travel to the 5* La Co(o)rniche in Pyla-sur-Mer where we will enjoy some incredible food and wine on the restaurant terrace, while watching the sunset over the Atlantic.
